## SHORTLISTING CRITERIA

### Minimum requirements

Applications will be assessed against the following minimum criteria. Submissions that do not meet these requirements will not be considered.

01 Availability and demonstrated readiness to take on assignments when called upon.

02 A minimum of **five (5) years of relevant experience** in the applicable thematic area. Individual CVs and a cover letter describing qualifications and relevant past engagements must be included. Firms must attach CVs for all key proposed staff.

03 Copies of relevant academic degrees, professional certifications, and any other supporting qualification documents.

04 Valid certificate of incorporation or registration, current tax compliance certificate, and any required professional licences. Foreign firms must provide equivalent documentation from their country of registration.
